FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Free School Meals (FSM) and Uniform Grants are available to parents in receipt of one of the following benefits: -

- Income Support;
- Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income of £16,190 or less;
- Universal credit and have net household earnings not exceeding £14,000 per year.

If you are entitled to apply for FSM we ask that you do so <u>as soon as possible</u>, even if your child does not want to have a meal provided by the EA School Meals Service, as it impacts on our annual budget from DE.

Still, unflavoured water or milk are the only drinks permitted during mid-morning break. **NUTS** are not allowed in any form.

Many thanks to everyone who has been sending packed lunches to school in disposable packaging. However, we realise that this is not always appropriate, especially on wet mornings. Therefore, if parents prefer, lunches can be sent in reusable lunchboxes. Just remember to wipe them carefully when you get them home!

SCHOOL DINNERS

Our School Meals staff are working very hard delivering lunches/meals to the classrooms to ensure that we maintain our 'protective bubbles'. Sandwiches will continue to be provided on Mondays and Tuesdays. A hot meal will be available the rest of the week. This will be reviewed at Halloween.

The cost of a school lunch is £2.60 per day or £13 per week. Money will only be accepted in a labelled and sealed envelope or plastic bag. No change can be given, so please send in correct amounts of money.
