SAFETY REMINDERS

COVID 19 SAFETY UPDATE

We are delighted that the children will be returning to school for face to face teaching this term! However, the level of Covid transmission in the community is very high so we ask for your support in following PHA advice to keep everyone safe. Please continue to exercise a cautious approach if children experience any coughs/colds/minor illness/raised temperatures.

If your child displays any of the key Covid symptoms, please do a lateral flow test and if it is positive they have to isolate for up to 10 days. The isolation period may be reduced from 10 days to seven, providing they have negative lateral flow results on both days 6 and 7 with tests taken 24 hours apart.

If your child is a close contact, they must take a lateral flow test as soon as possible. As long as this is negative, they can attend school <u>but</u> must continue to take daily lateral flow tests until the tenth day after the last date of contact with the positive case. If any of the tests are positive at any time during the 10 days, they should isolate immediately.

As you may have heard it is very difficult to get substitute teachers in the current circumstances. If teachers are ill and we cannot get substitutes, as a last resort, individual classes may be asked to remain at home for their safety.

However, this will only happen after we have exhausted all other options and for the shortest period possible.
