MORNING DROP OFF

Thanks to all our families for cooperating with the morning arrangements and dropping children at the school gates. This system has helped to create a calmer, safer and much less stressful start to the day for our pupils. Staff are on duty from 8.45-9am every morning. Gates are locked at 9am and children arriving later need to come in via the Antrim Road entrance.

We really appreciate the children arriving punctually in the mornings so that administration tasks can be carried out quickly and efficiently, and to ensure children do not miss out on learning opportunities. However, we do understand that occasionally families get delayed and may be a little late. If children are absent from school, parents should let us know on ClassDojo or by telephone so that the absences are coded correctly for DE.
