FAMILY ONLINE SAFETY WORKSHOP

Did your child receive their first digital device for Christmas? Do you know how to set privacy settings to keep them safe, or how to block, report and mute other users? Do you know who they are engaging with online?

As part of Safer Internet Week 2024, our Student Council, together with pupils from FS and KS1, have created a Family Online Safety Workshop video. This will be posted on Dojo on Mon 5th Feb to view. There will be practical advice and support as to how to keep children safe while navigating online resources.

Alongside this, there are details about the Department of Education NI 'Safer Schools NI' parent app. This app helps you to navigate the digital world and give you the tools to protect your child when they are online.



Search for 'Safer Schools NI' in the App/Play Store. Follow the instructions to register and create an account, select our school and input 2030 when asked for a code.

FAMILIES CONNECT PROGRAMME

Families Connect is a six-week programme taking place on Tue mornings starting on Feb 20th, aimed at **parents of P1** and P2 pupils. Each workshop lasts 2 hours and focuses on language, literacy, mathematics, numeracy as well as social and emotional development. The sessions, delivered by Ms Dorman and Ms Scannell, are informal, relaxed and hugely beneficial to your child's learning. Please contact your child's teacher asap if you are interested as places are very limited.

PARKING

We have had further complaints from neighbours regarding careless parking in the immediate vicinity of the school and are expecting a visit from the PSNI. Please remind whoever drops your child to school to park with care and consideration in the around the school, being careful not to block gateways, drives and footpaths. Please ask them to be especially vigilant when reversing. Parking on yellow zig- zag lines is an endorsable penalty, which means three points on a licence and a £65 fine. Double parking on the Antrim Road and parking too close to junctions may also lead to fines.
